



Novi Hat

This is my version of a fedora/bowler hat - with a trendy touch! Novi is a crochet hat with roll-up brim finished with a stripe in contrasting black. This hat is made with simple sc-ch stitches in an aran weight wool yarn. The chunky yarn together with the crochet stitches give the hat the structure and form it needs. A cool and versatile unisex accessory, for him and for her!

Finished Measurements:

Circumference = 55 cm Height = 22cm

Yarn alternative 1:

MC: Järbo Garn Raggi, 100g/150 m, 100% wool, grey. CC: small amount of black.

Yarn alternative 2:

MC: Debbie Bliss Donegal Aran Tweed, 50g/88m, color 281104 x 2. CC: small amount of black.

Needle:

1 x 5,5 mm (US I) hook

Tension

17 sts to 10cm measured over pattern using 5,5mm (US I) hook.

Note: each sc stitch is made in the ch-sp of last round, not the top of a sc st of last round.

Hat

Round 1. with MC, ch 2. 10 sc in the first ch. Join in beg. st. - 10 sts

Round 2. ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in each st. Join in beg. st. - 20 sts.

Round 3. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st - 30 sts.





Round 4. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] in next sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next 2 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st. - 40 sts.

Round 5. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] in next 2 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next 3 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st. - 50 sts.

Round 6. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp. [sc 1, ch 1] in each sp around. Join in beg. st. - 50 sts.

Round 7. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] in next 3 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next 4 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st. - 60 sts.

Round 8. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp. [sc 1, ch 1] in each sp around. Join in beg. st. - 60 sts.

Round 9. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] in next 4 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next 5 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st. - 70 sts.

Round 10. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp. [sc 1, ch 1] in each sp around. Join in beg. st. - 70 sts.

Round 11. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] in next 5 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next 6 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st. - 80 sts.

Round 12. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp. [sc 1, ch 1] in each sp around. Join in beg. st. - 80 sts.

Round 13. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1] in next 6 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1] in next 7 sp, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. * Repeat * - * around. Join in beg.

Round 14. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp. [sc 1, ch 1] in each sp around. Join in beg. st. - 90 sts.
Work as **Row 14.** 14 more rounds. Add more rounds here if you want to make a longer hat.

Stripe

Join CC with sl in first st, ch 2 (as first dc), dc in back loop only in each st around. - 90 sts.

Brim

Round 1. Join MC with sl in first sp, ch 1, in back loops only, [sc 1, ch 1] in same st, (skip 1 st, [sc 1, ch 1] in next st) x 3, skip 1 st, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next st, skip 1 st. * ([sc 1, ch 1] in next st, skip 1 st) x 4, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next st, skip 1 st*. Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. st - 108 st

Round 2-3. sl st to first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp. [sc 1, ch 1] in each sp around. Join in beg. st. - 108 sts.

Round 4. sl into first ch sp, ch 1, [sc 1, ch 1] in same sp, [sc 1, ch 1 in next sp] x 4, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp. *[sc 1, ch 1 in next sp] x 5, [sc 1, ch 1] x 2 in next sp*. Repeat * - * around. Join in beg. St. - 126 sts.

Work as **Round 2** for 6 more rounds. Fasten off. For a bowler hat, roll up the brim as in pictures.

For a fedora, fold top of hat and roll up back of brim.
