



CEDAR BOX KNITS



Wavy Moss Hats & Headband

GAUGE

4 inches = 15 sts worked in seed st

MATERIALS

Wavy Moss Beanie:

100 yds Cascade Eco yarn
6 st markers
Size US 10 (6mm) circular needle with 16" cord
Set of size US 10 (6mm) double pointed needles
36" waste yarn
Cable Needle
Darning needle to sew ends in

Wavy Moss Slouchy

155 yds Cascade Eco Yarn
3 st markers
Size US 10 (6mm) circular needle with 24" cord
Size US 10 (6mm) double pointed needles
36" waste yarn
Cable Needle
Darning needle to sew ends in

Wavy Moss Headband

50 yds Cascade Eco Yarn
Size US 10 (6mm) needles
36" waste yarn
Cable Needle
Darning needle to sew ends in

Choose from a fitted beanie, relaxed slouchy hat, or simple cabled headband. Each builds on a foundation of a band of cables and lets you choose the style from there!

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

C3B – knit 3, place 3 stitches on cable needle and hold to back, knit 3 from left hand needle, knit the 3 stitches from cable needle.
C3F – place 3 stitches on cable needle and hold to front, knit 3 from left hand needle, knit 3 from cable needle, knit 3 from left hand needle.
CO – cast on
DPNs – double pointed needles
K2tog – knit 2 stitches together
K - knit
Kfb – knit into the front and back of one stitch
M1 – increase one stitch
P – purl
Pm – place stitch marker
Rep – repeat
Seed st – First row is worked (K1, P1). Next row is worked by knitting the purl stitches and purling the knit stitches. In the round, this will be (P1, K1).
Sl m – slip stitch marker
Ssk – slip 2 stitches knitwise, then knit into the back of those 2 sts

*** Cable Band Instructions ***

Using provisional cast on CO 13 sts leaving a 20" tail.

Knit 1 row

Row 1: K1, P9, K1, P1, K1

Row 2: K1, P1, K11

Row 3: K1, P9, K1, P1, K1,

Row 4: K1, P1, K1, C3F, K1

Row 5: K1, P9, K1, P1, K1

Row 6: K1, P1, K11

Row 7: K1, P9, K1, P1, K1

Row 8: K1, P1, K1, C3B, K1

Repeat Rows 1-8 until band measures about 20" ending with row 8. Don't break working yarn.

Remove waste yarn from provisional cast on and place exposed sts on a needle. Using CO tail, graft both the first and last rows worked using Kitchener st to create a loop

Wavy Moss Slouchy Hat



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Circumference: 20" (51 cm) laid flat, 23" (58 cm) stretched

Rise: 12" (30.5 cm)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow instructions for Cable Band (above)

Using working yarn, and circular needle, pick up and knit 54 sts along the edge of the band. Pm to mark beginning of the row.

[[k1, p1) 3 times, m1, (p1, k1) 3 times, m1] 4 times, [(k1, p1) 3 times, m1].
(63 sts)

Work in seed st until work measures 7" from P/U row

Decrease

Continue in seed st as you work the following:

Set up row: {work 21 sts, pm} 3 times.

Row 1: {Sl m, K2tog, work to 2 sts before marker, ssk} 3 times

Row 2: work in seed st

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 three times more, switching to dpns when circumference is too small for circular needle
(39 sts)

Work Row 1 three times more (21 sts)

Remove all stitch markers

(K2tog, P2tog) until 5 sts rem. Break yarn and thread through remaining 5 sts. Pull tight and weave in ends.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 20" (51 cm) laid flat, 23" (58 cm) stretched

Rise: 8" (20 cm)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow instructions for Cable Band (above)

Pick up and knit 54 sts along the edge of the cable band, using circular needle. Pm to mark beginning of the row.

Work in seed st until hat measures 3.5" from P/U row.

Decrease

Set up row: {work in seed st for 9 sts, pm} 6 times

Row 1: {Sl m, K2tog, work in seed st to 2 sts before marker, ssk} 6 times

Row 2: work in seed st

Repeat rows 1 and 2 two times more, switching to dpns when circumference is too small for circular needle. (18 sts)

Remove st markers and (K2tog, P2tog) until 6 sts rem. Break yarn and thread through remaining 6 sts. Weave in ends to finish.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 20" (51 cm) laid flat, 23" (58 cm) stretched

Width: 3" (7.5 cm)

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Provisional cast on and waste yarn, CO 13 sts

K one row

Row 1: K1, P11, K1

Row 2: K1, P1, K9, P1, K1

Row 3: K1, P11, K1

Row 4: K1, P1, C3F, P1, K1

Row 5: K1, P11, K1

Row 6: K1, P1, K9, P1, K1

Row 7: K1, P11, K1

Row 8: K1, P1, C3B, P1, K1

Repeat rows 1-8 until work measures 20", ending with row 8.

Remove waste yarn and transfer sts to a needle. Graft CO edge to last row worked using Kitchener st. Weave in ends to finish.
