

SUPER STASH BUSTING SCARF

This simple and easy scarf will eat up your yarn stash in no time at all. It can be easily customised to any length, and finished with optional pompoms to make use of any leftover yarn. Alternate the colours in an endlessly customisable fashion to make each one truly unique!

Materials

- 4.5mm/H hook
- DK yarn in any type—the sample contains a minimum of 250g (800-1000yds) of acrylic yarn
- Scissors
- Pompom maker/cardboard for making pompom template (optional)
- Tapestry needle

Rnd7-Desired Length: As Rnd5 and Rnd6.

4th Last Rnd: Ch2, 1hdc 39 times, join with sl st (40).

3rd Last Rnd: Ch2, 2hdc, 2hdctog (dec) *3hdc, 2hdctog* to end, join with sl st (30).

2nd Last Rnd: Ch2, 1hdc, 2hdctog (dec), *2hdc, 2hdctog* to end, join with sl st (20).

Last Rnd: Ch1, set up hdc in next hdc and crochet together (1dec), 2hdctog to end, join with sl st and leave long tail for sewing (10).

NOTES: TURN AT THE END OF EVERY ROUND, WEAVE IN ENDS OF COLOUR CHANGES AS YOU GO.

Finishing

With the tapestry needle, weave the long tail in and close up the end. Make two pompoms and attach to each end.

Instructions

Start: Ch2, 9hdc in mc, join with sl, turn (10).

Rnd1: Ch2, 1hdc in same space, *2hdc in next hdc* to end, join with sl st (20).

Rnd2: Ch2, 2hdc in next hdc, *1hdc, 2hdc in next hdc* to end, join with sl st (30).

Rnd3: Ch2, 1hdc, 2hdc in next hdc, *2hdc, 2hdc in next hdc* to end, join with sl st (40).

Rnd4: Ch2, 1hdc in each hdc (40).

Rnd5: Ch2, 3hdc, ch2, 4hdc, sk 2hdc, *4hdc, ch2, 4hdc, sk 2hdc* to end, join with sl st.

Rnd6: Ch2, sk 2hdc, *4hdc, ch2, 4hdc, sk 2hdc* to last 3hdc, join to first ch with sl st.
