SIZES

Woman's small (medium, large)

Instructions are given for smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When only 1 number is given, it applies to all sizes.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

To fit actual foot length: 8¾ (9½, 10¼) inches

Cuff circumference: Approx 12 (13, 14¼) inches

Cuff length: Approx 4 (4, 4¼) inches

MATERIALS

- Plymouth Yarn Encore Chunky (chunky weight; 75% acrylic/25% wool; 143 yds/100g per ball): 2 (2, 3) balls light gray #0194
- Size 7 (4.5mm) double-point needles (set of 5) or size needed to obtain gauge
- 4 (1-inch) buttons

GAUGE

16 sts and 26 rnds = 4 inches/10cm in St st.

22 sts and 20 rnds/rows = 4 inches/10cm in Star St.

To save time, take time to check gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

N1, N2, N3, N4: Needle 1, Needle 2, Needle 3, Needle 4.

Make Star (MS): When working in the round: knit 3 sts tog but leave the sts on the left needle. Wrap yarn around the working needle once, then knit the same 3 sts tog again.

On WS when working flat: purl 3 sts tog but leave the sts on the left needle. Wrap yarn around the working needle once, then purl the same 3 sts tog again.



PATTERN STITCHES

Star Stitch in the round (multiple of 4 sts + 1)

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: K1, *MS, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: K3, MS, *k1, MS; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Rnds 1–4 for pat.



Star Stitch in rows (multiple of 4 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: P1, *MS, p1; rep from * across.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: P3, MS, *p1, MS; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Rep Rows 1–4 for pat.

PATTERN NOTES

Slipper is worked in 2 pieces using double-point needles. The foot is worked first; it is worked in the round and begins with the ankle, followed by the instep, the lower sides and finally the sole, which ends in the center. Center sole stitches can either be grafted for a seamless bottom or bound off and then sewn together. The cuff is worked sideways and then sewn to the lower foot section.

Slipper is worked at a tighter-than-normal gauge to ensure a dense, long-wearing fabric.

FOOT Ankle

With dpns, cast on 54 (58, 64) sts; distribute sts on 3 dpns as follows: N1: 17 (17, 21) sts; N2: 18 (20, 21) sts; N3: 19 (21, 22) sts. Mark beg of rnd and join.

Knit 1 rnd.

Continue working as follows: N1 (instep sts): Star St; N2 and N3: St st, until piece measures 1½ inches, ending with Rnd 2 of pat.

Instep

Working flat, continue with Row 3 in Star St across N1; turn, (leaving rem sts on hold on N2 and N3). Work until instep measures 5 (5¼, 5¾) inches from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2 of pat.

Lower Sides

Pick-up rnd: Knit across N1, then pick up and knit 12 (14, 16) sts along the left edge of instep; knit across N2, mark new beg of rnd (back of heel); knit across N3; with 4th dpn (N4), pick up and knit 12 (14, 16) sts along right edge of instep, work 8 (8, 10) sts from N1—78 (86, 96) sts on 4 dpns with the first half on N3 and N4 and the 2nd half on N1 and N2.

Continue around in St st until lower sides measure approx 1 inch from Pick-up rnd, ending at back of heel.

SOLE

Purl 1 rnd.

Knit 1 rnd.

Dec rnd: N3: K2, k2tog, k1, k2tog, knit to end; N4: Knit to last 7 sts, ssk, k1, ssk, k2; N1 and N2: Work as for N3 and N4—70 (78, 88) sts.

Continuing in St st, rep Dec rnd every other rnd until sole measures approx 1½ (1½, 1¾) inches from purl rnd.

Seamless sole option: Do not bind off. Cut yarn, leaving a very long tail for grafting. Transfer sts from N2 to N1 and sts from N4 to N3. Graft sts tog using Kitchener st.

Seamed sole option: Bind off. Cut yarn, leaving a very long tail for seaming. Fold sole lengthwise (between paired dec lines), then sew a flat center seam.

CUFF

Cast on 23 (23, 27) sts.

Knit 1 WS row.

Work flat in Star St with 1 st in St st each side, until cuff measures approx 12½ (13½, 14¾) inches, ending with Row 3 of pat.

Dec row (WS): K3, *k2tog, k2; rep from * to end—18 (18, 21) sts.

Next row: K3, bind off 4 sts, knit to last 7 sts, bind off 4 sts, knit to end—10 (10, 13) sts.

Next row: K3, cast on 5 sts, k4 (4, 7), cast on 5 sts, knit to end—20 (20, 23) sts.

Bind off all sts kwise.

ASSEMBLY

Fold cuff so short edges overlap by approx ¾ inch.

Sew 2 buttons along 1 edge, to fit button lps on edge opposite side.

Position cuff so that it overlaps foot edge by approx ½ inch; buttons should be on the outside of slipper; pin in place.

With WS facing, invisibly sew cuff to cast-on edge of foot using whipstitch or desired seaming technique; where cuff edges overlap, sew through all layers.

Weave in ends. ●

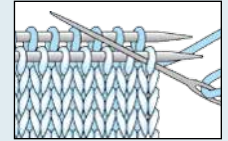

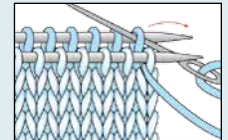
KITCHENER STITCH

This method of weaving with two needles is used for the toes of socks and flat seams. To weave the edges together and form an unbroken line of stockinette stitch, divide all stitches evenly onto two knitting needles—one behind the other. Thread yarn into tapestry needle. Hold needles with wrong sides together and work from right to left as follows:

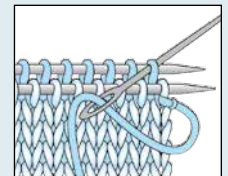
Step 1: Insert tapestry needle into first stitch on front needle as to purl. Draw yarn through stitch, leaving stitch on knitting needle.



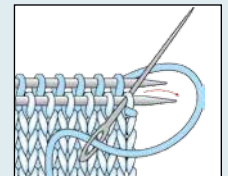
Step 2: Insert tapestry needle into the first stitch on the back needle as to purl. Draw yarn through stitch and slip stitch off knitting needle.



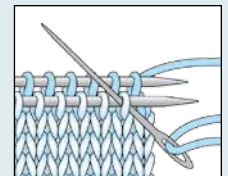
Step 3: Insert tapestry needle into the next stitch on same (back) needle as to knit, leaving stitch on knitting needle.



Step 4: Insert tapestry needle into the first stitch on the front needle as to knit. Draw yarn through stitch and slip stitch off knitting needle.



Step 5: Insert tapestry needle into the next stitch on same (front) needle as to purl. Draw yarn through stitch, leaving stitch on knitting needle.



Repeat Steps 2 through 5 until one stitch is left on each needle. Then repeat Steps 2 and 4. Fasten off. Woven stitches should be the same size as adjacent knitted stitches.
