

HOLEY HAT

A ponytail-friendly hat pattern
by SplitStitch Designs

Materials:

One skein (130 yards) of bulky
yarn—quite a bit will be left
over.

Original knit: Berroco
Vintage Chunky

Needles:

Sizes US 9 and 10
(Sample was knit using
“Magic Loop” method.)



Notions:

Tapestry Needle, beginning of round marker if desired.

Gauge:

4 stitches, 6 rows per 1 inch in stockinette stitch

PATTERN:

Using smaller needles, cast on 56 stitches using backwards loop or preferred method. Join to work in the round.

Work two inches of 1x1 ribbing. (*K1, P1* repeat)

Change to larger needles and work in stockinette stitch for an additional 6 inches.

Decreasing:

- K2tog all the way around (28 stitches remaining)
- Knit one round
- K2tog all the way around (14 stitches remaining)
- Knit one round
- Purl one round

***Note:** My hair is very thick, but this hole was large enough to pull mine through. Depending on the recipient's hair, you may alter how many stitches you leave remaining on your last decrease row.

Bind off *loosely*, weave in the ends, and block if desired. Enjoy!



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
