

HERRINGBONE NECKWARMER

Materials:

- 1 skein Twinkle Soft Chunky or approximately 83 yards of a super bulky weight yarn
- Size US19 straight needles
- Two 2" buttons
- Tapestry needle

Horizontal Herringbone Stitch:

Row 1: K1, * slip 1 (purlwise), K1, yo, pass slipped stitch over the knit stitch and yarn over (pssO)*, repeat between asterisks until last stitch, K1.

Row 2: P2tog do not slip stitches off left needle, purl into first stitch again, slip both stitches off left needle. Repeat this across the row.

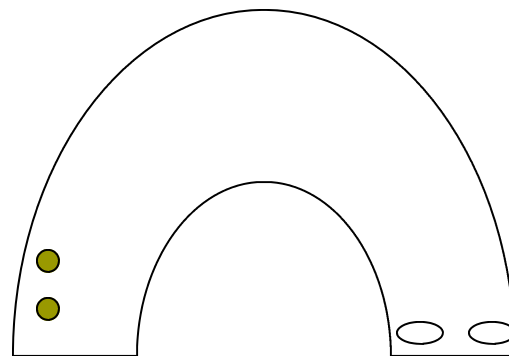
Let's Get Started:

Cast on 20 stitches.

Work in Horizontal Herringbone stitch until your piece is long enough to wrap around your neck comfortably and you have approximately 6 yards of yarn left.

For your last purl row: [P2tog, P into first stitch again] 3 times, P2tog, [P2tog, P into first stitch again] 2 times, P2tog, [P2tog, P into first stitch again] 3 times.

Finish by binding off loosely on the next row. Cut a 6" tail and weave in ends. Sew on the two buttons using the remaining yarn and tapestry needle.
