## Skill Level

Easy

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference $x$ Length (approximately):
$69 \times 15(93 \times 15) \mathrm{cm}, 271 / 4 \times 6(363 / 4 \times 6) \mathrm{in}$.

## MATERIALS

## Short Version / First Size :

$1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ball of Rialto 4 ply 52 Petal (A)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ball of Rialto 4 ply 53 Vintage Pink (B)

## Long Version / Second Size:

$2 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ball of Rialto 4 ply 56 Mint (A)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ball of Rialto 4ply 02 Ecru (B)
$1 \times 3.25 \mathrm{~mm} /$ UK10/US3 circular needle $40 \mathrm{~cm} / 16$ in long for the smaller cowl.
$1 \times 3.25 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{UK} 10 / \mathrm{US} 3$ circular needle $60 \mathrm{~cm} / 24 \mathrm{in}$ long for the larger cowl.
Stitch marker.

## TENSION

29 sts and 65 rows to 10 cm (4in) square over patt on $3.25 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{UK} 10 / \mathrm{US} 3$ needles.
It is essential to work to the correct tension. If there are less stitches, use a thinner needle, if there are more stitches, use a thicker needle.

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ABBREVIATIONS
beg = beginning; cm = centimetres; grm = grammes;
in = inch(es); }\mathbf{k}=\mathrm{ knit; mm = millimetres; p = purl;
patt = pattern; rep = repeat; rnd(s) = round(s); s1p
wyib = slip 1 stitch purlways with yarn in back; st(s)= stitch(es)
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Note: The yarn amounts are based on average requirements for the specified tension and yarn.


Using $3.25 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{UK} 10 / \mathrm{US} 3$ circular needle and A, cast on 200[270] sts, taking care not to twist sts.
Place a stitch marker between first and last cast-on sts to indicate beg and end of rounds.
Join to make a round and work as follows:-
Rnd 1: Knit.
Rnd 2: Purl.
These 2 rnds form garter st.
Work 3 rounds more in garter st.
Join in B, and work in patt as follows:-
Rnd 1: Using B, *s1p wyib, k1, rep from * to end.
Rnd 2: Using B, *s1p wyib, p1, rep from * to end.
Rnd 3: Using A, *k5, s1p wyib, k4, rep from * to end.
Rnd 4: Using A, *p5, s1p wyib, p4, rep from * to end.
Rnd 5: Using B, *(k1, s1p wyib) twice, k3, s1p wyib, k1, s1p wyib, rep from * to end.

Rnd 6: Using B, *(p1, s1p wyib) twice, p3, s1p wyib, p1, s1p wyib, rep from * to end.
Rnd 7: Using A, *k4, s1p wyib, k1, s1p wyib, k3, rep from * to end.
Rnd 8: Using A, *p4, s1p wyib, p1, s1p wyib, p3, rep from * to end.
Rnd 9: Using B, *s1p wyib, k1, s1p wyib, k5, s1p wyib, k1, rep from * to end.


Rnd 10: Using B, *s1p wyib, p1, s1p wyib, p5, s1p wyib, p1, rep from * to end.
Rnd 11: Using A, *k3, (s1p wyib, k1) twice, s1p wyib, k2, rep from * to end.
Rnd 12: Using A, *p3, (s1p wyib, p1) twice, s1p wyib, p2, rep from * to end.
Rnd 13: Using B, *k1, s1p wyib, k7, s1p wyib, rep from * to end.
Rnd 14: Using B, *p1, s1p wyib, p7, s1p wyib, rep from * to end.
Rnd 15: Using A, *k2, (s1p wyib, k1) 4 times, rep from

* to end.

Rnd 16: Using A, *p2, (s1p wyib, p1) 4 times, rep from * to end.
Rnd 17: Using B, *s1p wyib, k9, rep from * to end.
Rnd 18: Using B, *s1p wyib, p9, rep from * to end.
Rnd 19: Using A, *k1, slp wyib, rep from * to end.
Rnd 20: Using A, *p1, s1p wyib, rep from * to end.
Rnd 21: Using B, knit.
Rnd 22: Using B, purl.
Rnds 23 and 24: As rnds 19 and 20.
Rnds 25 and 26: As rnds 17 and 18.
Rnds 27 and 28: As rnds 15 and 16.
Rnds 29 and 30: As rnds 13 and 14.
Rnds 31 and 32: As rnds 11 and 12.
Rnds 33 and 34: As rnds 9 and 10.

Rnds 35 and 36: As rnds 7 and 8.
Rnds 37 and 38: As rnds 5 and 6.
Rnds 39 and 40: As rnds 3 and 4.
Rnds 41 and 42: As rnds 1 and 2.
Rnd 43: Using A, knit.
Rnd 44: Using A, purl.
Rep from rnds 1 to 44 once more.
Break off B.
Using A, beg with rnd 1, work 5 rnds in garter st.
Cast off purlways.

## Finishing

Block out if required. Refer to yarn label for care instructions.
