

Start with 3 colors. Each "block" is 9 stitches so for however wide you want the blanket, count in 9 to get your foundation (and always make it an uneven number of "blocks) eg: 19 blocks(makes it about $5^{\prime}$ long) $19 \times 9=171$ stitches then add $4=175 \mathrm{sc}$ for the foundation row.

Row 1-2:Sc, switch to next color Row 3: sc 2 stitches,* front post double crochet(look it up), sc, until you have 5 posts, sc 9 , then repeat post pattern( 5 posts, $4 \mathrm{sc}=9$ )( 9 sc ), 2 sc (there is 2 sc at each end) Row 4: sc, switch to next color

Repeat row 3-4 until you have 7 rows of posts
Then switch the pattern to: Row 1: sc 11 stitches, then start pattern Row 4: sc, switch to next c
So you will have your "blocks" of ( 5 posts \& 4sc) and ( 9 sc ) with 2 sc at each end.
Im not a pattern writer :) i hope its not too confusing. Please post if you have any questions!
