

Angel Wings Photography Prop

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Materials:

- Small amount of crochet thread or fingering weight yarn
- US B1/2.25 mm hook
- Sewing needle and thread
- Sugar-water solution for hardening, optional

Gauge: after the 5th round is finished, it should be 1 ½ " tall.

Abbrevations:

- Ch chain
- Sl st slip stitch
- Sc single crochet
- Dc double crochet
- Dc2tog 2 double crochet finished together
- Dc3tog 3 double crochet finished together
- Dc4tog 4 double crochet finished together

Row 1: ch 3, 3 dc in first ch, turn.

Row 2: ch 2, 3 dc in same st, 3 dc in next 2 sts. 9 sts. Turn.

Row 3: ch 2, 3 dc in same st, dc in next dc, 3 dc in next dc, *ch 1, 3 dc in next st, dc in next st, 3 dc in next st* rep 1 more time, turn. 21 dc.

Row 4: ch 2, dc in same st, dc in next 6 dc, *ch 1, dc in next 7 dc* rep one more time, turn. 21 dc.

Row 5: ch 2, dc in same st, dc in next 6 dc, *ch 2, dc in next 7 dc* rep one more time, turn. 21 dc.

Row 6: ch 2, dc in next 4 dc, dc2tog in next 2 dc, *[ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2] in next ch-2 sp, dc2tog in next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, dc2tog in next 2 dc* rep one more time, turn.

Row 7: ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog in next 2 dc, *ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc2tog in next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc2tog in next 2 dc* rep one more time, turn.

Row 8: ch 2, dc2tog in next 2 dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, dc3tog in next 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, dc3tog in next 3 dc, turn.

Row 9: ch 5, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc3tog, ch 4, dc4tog in next 4 dc (in 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc), ch 2, dc in last dc2tog, turn.

Row 10: ch 4, dc in next dc4tog, ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, dc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 11: ch 5, dc4tog in next 4 dc (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc), ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc4tog in next 4 dc (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc), ch 2, dc in next dc, turn.

Row 12: ch 4, dc in next dc4tog, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc, ch 2, dc in next dc4tog, ch 2, dc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 13: ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc4tog in next 4 dc (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc), ch 2, dc in next dc, turn.

Row 14: ch 2, dc2tog in next dc4tog and last dc.

Finishing round: ch 1, sc in same st, ch 3, go around the wing with sc stitches, join to first sc with sl st, fasten off.

Make two. Sew them together just about a half an inch long in the middle as shown on the photo.

Wings on the photo have been hardened with a sugar-water (1-1) solution.
