

The Cosy Crochet Nook ~ MissJinty Designs

Dinosaur Baby Booties RAWR! - 3 sizes 0-3, 3-6, 6-9 months

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Hello everyone! Thank you for taking the time to download my latest pattern!

Materials needed:

Dk (light worsted) yarn of your choosing! I've used Hayfield Bonus

Dk (colours shown are Spring Green and Orange)

4mm and for newborn size use a 3.5mm hook

Yarn Needle

Stitch Markers should you wish you keep track

Abbreviations: American terms Used:

ch = chain

ss = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
BLO = Back loop only
sc2tog = single crochet two together
Dc2tog = Double crochet two together
MR = Magic Ring

Size 0-3 (3-6, 6-9 months)

Sole: Make 2

Ch 11 (12, 13)

R1: 2 hdc into the 2nd chain from the hook, hdc in to the next 8 chains (9, 10) 6 hdc into the last chain

now we work along the bottom side to get back to the beginning

Hdc into the next 8 chains (9, 10) and do a final 2 hdc into the last stitch (this has the 2hdc from the beginning) and join with ss to the first sc of the row

R2: ch 1, 2 sc into same stitch, 2 sc into the next stitch, sc in to the next 8 stitches (9, 10) hdc in to next stitch, 2hdc into the next 5 stitches, hdc in to next stitch, sc in to the next 8 stitches, 2 sc in to the last 2 stitches and join with ss to the first sc of the row. (9, 10)

R3: ch 1 and hdc in to the same stitch, 2 hdc in to the next stitch, hdc in to the next stitch, 2 hdc in to the next stitch. Hdc in to the next 9 stitches (10, 11) *2hdc, 1hdc* do for a total of 6 times. Hdc into the next 8 stitches (9, 10) *2hdc, 1hdc* twice, ss to the first hdc of the row. Fasten off.

Bootie:

R4: Attach bootie colour in BLO, ch1 and sc in same space, sc around in BLO, join with ss to first sc of the row

R5: * now back to working both loops* ch1 and sc in same stitch, sc around and join with a ss to the first sc

R6: ch1 and hdc in same stitch, hdc around and join with a ss to the first hdc

R7: ch1 and sc in to the next 2 stitches, sc2tog, sc in the next 8 stitches (9, 10) hdc in the next 2 stitches, Dc2tog for a total of 10 times, hdc in the next 2 stitches, sc in the next 8 stitches, (9, 10) sc2tog, sc in the last 2 stitches and join with ss to the first sc

R8: ch1 and sc in to the same stitch, sc in to the next 11 stitches, (12, 13) hdc in to the next 2 stitches, Dc2tog for a total of 4 times, hdc in to the next 2 stitches, sc in to the next 12 stitches (13, 14) and join with ss to the first sc

R9: ch1 and sc in to the next stitch, sc in to the next 10 (11, 12) stitches, hdc in to the next 2 stitches, Dc2tog for a total of 3 times, hdc in to the next 2 stitches, sc in to the next 11 stitches (12, 13) and join with ss to the first sc

R10-13: ch1 and hdc in to same stitch, hdc all around and join with ss to first hdc

R14: ch1 sc in same stitch and all around, join with ss to first sc and fasten off, weave in all ends

Repeat this on the other sole.

Spikes: Make 4

R1: Using MR 5sc in to ring (don't ss to join we are working in a continuous round!)

R2: sc around (5sc)

R3: *inc, 1sc* repeat around (8sc)

R4: sc around (8sc) fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing on to the bootie

Using a picture as a guide, sew your spikes on to the back of each bootie, weave in ends and you'll have yourself a complete pair of cute baby booties!

As usual I don't mind you selling your finished projects but please don't copy this pattern and pass off as your own, give the designer

credit when it's due. It takes a lot of effort to design, test and write these patterns out.
