



Skill Level:

Easy



Tulip Bulb

Gauge: with 2.75 mm hook, 6 sc sts & 7 rows = 1 inch

Materials Needed:

DK weight / #3 yarn in colors: Cream,
Tan, Green, Pink, Lime Green
2.75 mm hook
Fiber fill stuffing
Yarn needle
Stitch marker
(2) 6 mm safety eyes

Measurements:

6 inches tall by 2 1/2 inches wide

Abbreviations:

BLO- back loops only
ch(s)- chain(s)
dc- double crochet
FLO- front loops only
hdc- half double crochet
rnd- round
rpt- repeat
sc- single crochet
sc2tog- single crochet 2 stitches together
sk- skip
sl st- slip stitch
st(s)- stitch(es)
tr- treble crochet
yo- yarn over

Notes:

-The () at the end of each round states the total number of stitches that should be completed for that round.

-Tension is not critical for this project. You can use any yarn to make this amigurumi. For example, if you use a larger hook and a suitable yarn, the amigurumi will be bigger while maintaining the same proportions.



Bulb:

with 2.75 mm hook, and cream yarn, ch 2

Beginning at the bottom of the bulb

Rnd 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (6 total sts)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around (12 total sts)

Rnd 3: change to tan yarn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (18 total sts)

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (24 total sts)

Rnd 5: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (30 total sts)

Rnd 6: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (36 total sts)

Rnd 7: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (42 total sts)

Rnd 8: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (48 total sts)

Rnd 9-13: sc in each st around (48 total sts)

Insert 6 mm safety eyes between rounds

10 and 11 with 5 stitches in between.

With yarn needle stitch on mouth and cheeks. See picture 1.

Rnd 14: *sc next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (42 total sts)

Rnd 15: *sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (36 total sts)

Rnd 16: *sc next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (30 total sts)

Begin stuffing with fiberfill.



Rnd 17: *sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (24 total sts)

Rnd 18: sc in each st around (24 total sts)

Rnd 19: *sc next st, sc2tog, sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (18 total sts)

Rnd 20: sc in each st around (18 total sts)

Rnd 21: *sc2tog, sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (12 total sts)

Rnd 22: change to green yarn, working in BLO, sc in each st around (12 total sts)

Rnd 23: *working in BLO, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (9 total sts)

Rnd 24-26: sc in each st around (9 total sts)

Rnd 27: change to pink yarn, working in BLO, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (12 total sts)

Rnd 28-33: sc in each st around (12 total sts)

Rnd 34: *sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (10 total sts)

Rnd 35: *sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (8 total sts)

Rnd 36: *sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (6 total sts)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Finish stuffing with fiberfill. With yarn needle weave in and out of the FLO of the remaining

stitches to sew up the top opening. Weave in ends.

Rnd 37: join lime green yarn in any front loop from rnd 23, *sl st in next st, ch 8, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch st, hdc in next 5 ch sts, sl st in next 2 sts from rnd 23, ch 10, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch st, hdc in next 7 ch sts, sl st in next st from rnd 23, rpt from * 3 times total.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Rnd 38: join tan yarn in any front loop from rnd 22, *sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (15 total sts)

Rnd 39: sc in each st around (15 total sts)

Fasten off and weave in ends. Tie short lengths of cream yarn to rnds 1 and 2. Cut them all the same length and unravel the yarn to make it fuzzy.



with 2.75 mm hook and pink yarn, ch 2

Rnd 1: 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook (4 total sts)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (6 total sts)

Rnd 3: *sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (8 total sts)

Rnd 4: *sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (10 total sts)



Rnd 5: *sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (12 total sts)

Rnd 6: sc in each st around (12 total sts)

Rnd 7: *sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (14 total sts)

Rnd 8: sc in each st around (14 total sts)

Rnd 9: *sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (16 total sts)

Rnd 10: sc in each st around (16 total sts)

Rnd 11: *sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (18 total sts)

Rnd 12: sc in each st around (18 total sts)

Rnd 13: *sc2tog, sc in next st, rpt from * until end of rnd (12 total sts)

Rnd 14: *sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, rpt from * until end of rnd (10 total sts)

Fasten off and leave a 12 inch yarn tail for sewing. Do not stuff with fiberfill but flatten. Sew round 14 together to close the opening.

Make a total of 3 petals. Sew round 14 of the petal to the front loops of round 26 of the bulb. Sew the sides of the petals together about half way up. See pictures 2 and 3.
