

Crochet Halloween Pumpkin Mask Pattern

Skill Level: Easy

Size: Fits most kids (adjust yarn/hook for other sizes)

Materials

Worsted weight yarn: Orange (main), Black (face), Green (stem/leaf)

Hook: 4.0 mm (G)

Notions:

- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR: Magic Ring

ch: Chain

sc: Single Crochet

inc: Increase (2 sc in same st)

dec: Decrease (sc2tog)

sl st: Slip Stitch

st: Stitch

Mask Base

Start with MR, 6 sc in ring. (6)

inc around -> (2 sc in each st) (12)

(sc, inc) x6 -> (18)

(2 sc, inc) x6 -> (24)

(3 sc, inc) x6 -> (30)

(4 sc, inc) x6 -> (36)

(5 sc, inc) x6 -> (42)

(6 sc, inc) x6 -> (48)

(7 sc, inc) x6 -> (54)

(8 sc, inc) x6 -> (60)

sc around (60)

Fasten off and weave ends.

Eye Holes

Count from the top center ~6 sts to the right, attach yarn:

ch 1, sc 12, ch 12, skip 12, sc next 12, ch 12, skip 12, sc to end.

sl st around eye holes to firm up.

Face Details (Black)

Make separately and sew on with a tapestry needle:

Eyes (Make 2):

ch 5

Row 1: sc 4

Row 2: dec, sc 2

Row 3: dec, sc

Row 4: dec

Fasten off

Nose (Make 1): Same pattern as eyes, just ch 4 instead of 5

Mouth:

ch 20

sc along, shaping points with dec and inc to create a zigzag/jagged look

Or use felt if you prefer simpler sewing

Stem & Leaf (Green)

Stem: ch 6, sc 5, sl st to top center of mask

Leaf (optional): ch 6, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc, sl st back to stem

Ear Loops (Make 2)

Attach orange yarn to the side

ch 15-20 (adjust for fit), sl st to the other side

Repeat on the opposite side

Finishing

Weave in all ends

Steam lightly to flatten if needed

Optional: Line back with felt for comfort
