FINISHED SIZES

Instructions are for up to 8-inch sole (*small*). Changes for 9-inch sole (*medium*) and 10-inch sole (*large*) are in []. When only 1 number is given, it applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

- Premier Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (4 oz/203 yds/113g per skein):
2 skeins #1025 scarlet
- Sizes F/5/3.75mm and H/8/5mm crochet hooks or sizes needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



GAUGE

With size F hook and 2 strands held tog: 15 sc = 4 inches

With size F hook and 1 strand: 9 sc = 2 inches

With size H hook and 1 strand: 4 sc = 1 inch

PATTERN NOTE

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

BOOT

Make 2.

Sole

Row 1: With size F hook and 2 strands held tog, beg at Heel, ch 4, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch, turn. (5 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (7 sc)

Rows 3–14: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 15: Rep row 2. (9 sc)



Sizes Medium & Large Only

Rows [16–18]: Rep row 3.

Rows [19–22, 19–26]: [Rep rows 15–18 consecutively] [1, 2] time(s). (*[11, 13] sc at end of last row*)

All Sizes

Rows 16–25 [23–27, 27–32]: Rep row 3.

Row 26 [28, 33]: Ch 1, sk first sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc dec in last 2 sc, turn. (*7 [9, 11] sts*)

Rows 27–28 [29–32, 34–37]: Rep rows 16 and 26 [23 and 28, 27 and 33] alternately. (*5 [5, 7] sts at end of row 28 [32, 37]*)

Row 29 [33, 38]: Ch 1, sk first st, sc in each st across to last st, ch 1, sl st in last st. Fasten off. (*3 [3, 5] sc*)

Heel

First Side

Getting started: Heel and Toe will be worked around entire Sole into end sts of rows along sides or into bottoms and tops of sts across Heel and Toe ends of Sole.

Row 1: With size H hook, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 of Sole, **join** (*see Pattern Note*) 1 strand in ch at base of center sc of row 1, ch 11, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 9 chs, sl st in next 2 sts or row ends on Sole, turn. (*10 sc*)

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, working in **back lps** (*see Stitch Guide*), sk all sl sts, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, working in back lps, sc in each sc across, sl st into each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn.

Rows 4–12 [4–16, 4–22]: [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] 5 [7, 10] times, ending last rep with row 2. At end of last row, **do not fasten off**.

Toe

Getting started: Continue to work all rows of Toe in back lps unless otherwise specified.

Row 1: Sl st in each of first 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc across, sl st in end st of each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sk last 2 sl sts made, sc in each sc across to first sl st, sl st in each sl st, turn. (*11 sts*)

Row 3: Ch 1, sl st in each sl st across to first sc, sl st in each of first 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc across, sl st in end st of each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn.

Rows 4–8: [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] 3 times, ending last rep with row 2. (*14 sts at end of last row*)

Row 9: Ch 1, sl st in each sl st across to first sc, sl st in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, sl st in end st of each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sk next 2 sl sts, sc in each sc, sl st in each sl st across, turn. (*16 sts*)

Rows 11 & 12: Rep rows 9 and 10. (*18 sts at end of last row*)

Row 13: Ch 1, sl st in each sl st across to first sc, sl st in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, sl st in end of each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn.

Rows 14 & 15: Rep rows 12 and 13. (*22 sts at end of last row, not counting last 2 sl sts worked into edge of Sole*)

Row 16: Sk next 2 sl sts, hdc in each of next 5 sc, sc in each sc and sl st in each sl st across, turn.

Row 17: Ch 1, sl st in each sl st across to first sc, sl st in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each st across to last hdc, 2 sc in last hdc, sl st in end st of each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn. (*24 sts, not counting last 2 sl sts worked into edge of Sole*)

Row 18: Rep row 16.

Rows 19–22: [Rep rows 17 and 18 alternately] twice. (*28 sts at end of last row*)

Row 23: Ch 1, sl st in each sl st across to last sl st before first sc, sc dec in last sl st and first sc, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc dec in last 2 sts, sl st in each of next 2 row ends or sts on Sole, turn.

Row 24: Ch 1, sk 2 sl sts, sc in each sc and sc dec, sl st in each sl st across, turn. (*26 sts*)

Rows 25–28: [Rep rows 23 and 24 alternately] twice. (*22 sts at end of last row*)

Row 29: Ch 1, sl st in each sl st across to 2 sl sts before first sc, sc dec in next 2 sl sts, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc dec in last 2 sts, sl st in each of next 2 row ends or sts on sole, turn.

Row 30: Rep row 24. (*20 sts*)

Rows 31–40: [Rep rows 29 and 30 alternately] 5 times. Do not fasten off. (*10 sts at end of last row*)

Heel

2nd Side

Row 1: Working across last row of Toe, rep row 3 of Heel First Side.

Rows 2–12 [2–16, 2–22]: [Rep rows 2 and 3 of Heel First Side alternately] 6 [8, 11] times, ending last rep with row 2 and last sl st in same st as joining sl st on Heel First Side. At end of last row, do not fasten off. Remove hook from lp. With separate strand and tapestry needle, sew first and last rows tog for center back seam.

Top

Rnd 1: With RS facing, using size F hook, pick up dropped lp, working in ends of rows around, sk first row of Heel First Side, [sc in next row, sk next row] 2 [5, 10] times, sc in each of next 7 [5, 1] row(s), work evenly sp 15 sc across next 40 rows of Toe section, working across Heel 2nd Side, sc in each of next 8 [6, 2] rows, [sk next row, sc in next row] 2 [5, 10] times. Do not join. (34 [36, 38] sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in beg sc.

Rnds 3 & 4: Rep rnd 2. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Cuff

Row 1: Ch 23, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, sl st in each of next 2 sts on rnd 4 of Top, turn. (22 sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sk sl sts, sc in back lp of each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across, sl st in each of next 2 sts on rnd 4 of Top, turn.

Rows 4–34 [4–36, 4–38]: [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] 16 [17, 18], ending last rep with row 2 and working last sl st in same st as joining sl st. At end of last row, leaving long end, fasten off,

Sew first and last rows tog for center back seam. ■

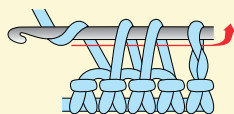

dtr (double treble crochet)	=	ttr (triple treble crochet)

Single crochet decrease (sc dec):

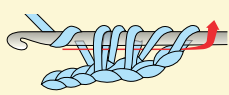
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):

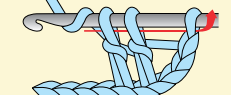
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

Double crochet decrease (dc dec):

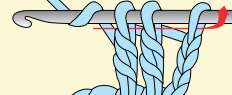
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



Example of 2-dc dec

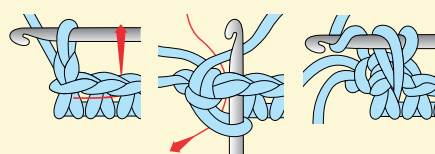
Treble crochet decrease (tr dec):

Hold- ing back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

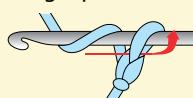


Example of 2-tr dec

Reverse single crochet (reverse sc): Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo and draw through both lps on hook.

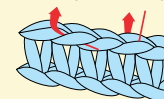


Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.

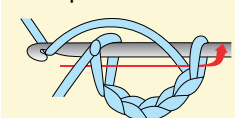


Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)

Front Loop Back Loop

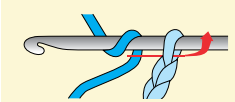


Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.

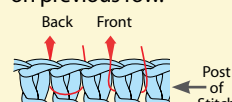


Chain color change (ch color change)

Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.

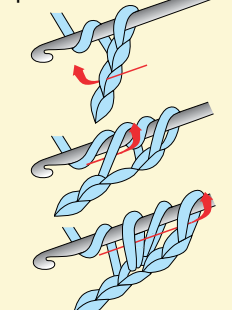


Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.



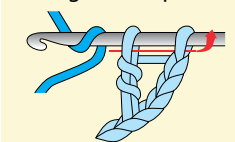
Half double crochet (hdc):

Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



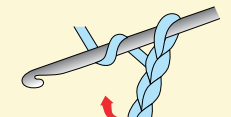
Double crochet color change (dc color change)

Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



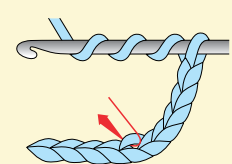
Double crochet (dc):

Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.



Double treble crochet (dtr):

Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



Treble crochet (tr): Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
